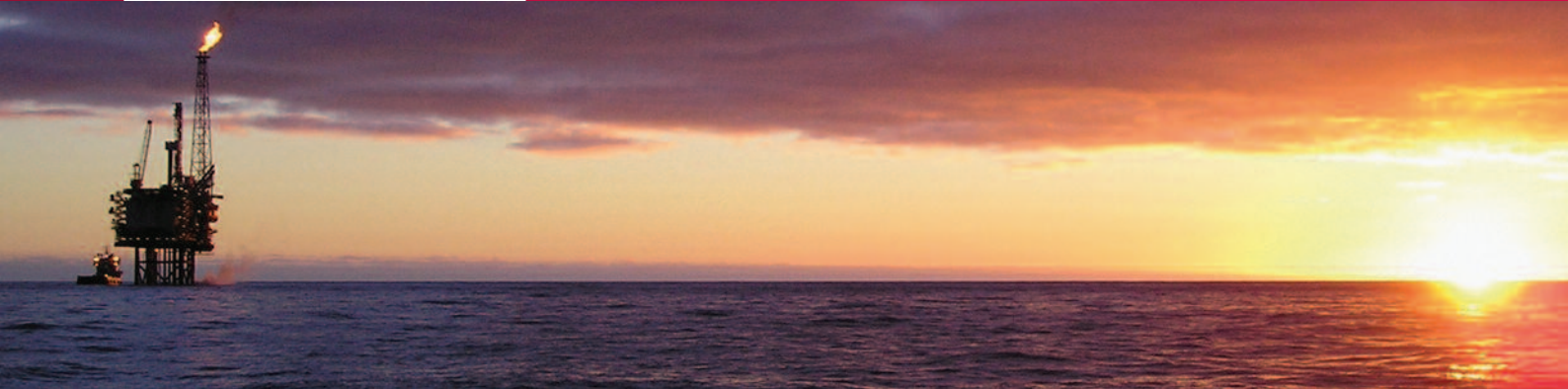

Improving Safety Culture on Term Chartered Vessels

The Background

A client came to ASCO Marine with a dilemma. They wished to improve the safety culture and reduce the number of recordable incidents/near-misses onboard their term chartered vessels.

From the basis of their Goal being **“No Harm to People or Damage to the Environment”**

The Process

The ASCO Marine Team got together to establish a way forward. It was obvious that the ship owners/managers would have a process in place to ensure safety of its crews, how could ASCO Marine add to this established process.
